The United States Navy announces a **PUBLIC MEETING** to discuss remedial alternatives for the **NAVAL WEAPONS STATION (NWS) EARLE COLTS NECK, N.J.**



These sites were included in the Installation Restoration Program because of surface soil contamination. The Navy has completed a Remedial Investigation and Removal Actions for each of the OU-4 sites and has issued a Proposed Plan which recommends no further remedial actions. In coordination with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the New Jersey Department of Environment Protection, the Navy is holding the meeting to present and discuss remediation alternatives and to solicit public input on the Proposed Plan. The meeting will be held in conjunction with the regularly scheduled meeting of the NWS Earle Restoration Advisory Board on:

No significant immediate risk to human health or ecological receptors has been found at any of the sites, but the removal actions were conducted to minimize the potential of any future impact. Confirmatory sampling was performed to determine the success of the removal operations.

Public comments are encouraged at the public meeting and written comments are also welcome. All significant comments and questions will be ad-
