Enclosed is a copy of the signed Record of Decision for Site 7, (Operable Unit 9) at Naval Weapons Station (NWS) Earle, Colts Neck, New Jersey. Based on our review of NWS Earle's Investigation Report and Feasibility Study, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concurs with the Record of Decision.

The Record of Decision calls for the following action at the facility:

**Site 7 – Landfill South of “P” Barricades (Operable Unit 10):** No action has been selected for this site.

This decision document addresses only the above site. Other areas of concern either have already been addressed through removal actions or will be addressed in future Records of Decision. Please note that although a remedial action is not warranted pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) at Site 7, future use or construction within this area may be subject to appropriate state and/or local regulations/requirements.
