The United States Navy invites you to discuss remedial alternatives for Operable Unit 10 (OU 10), Site 7 Landfill at the NWS Earle. Site 7 consists of an approximately five-acre former landfill located within the Chapel Hill portion of the NWS Earle Water-front Area in Middletown Township. The Navy has completed a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study for the site and has issued a Proposed Plan which outlines recommended remedial actions in coordination with the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, the Navy is holding a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting to present and discuss remediation alternatives and to solicit public input on the Proposed Plan. The meeting will be held on:

The Preferred Alternative for the OU 10 site consists of a vegetated soil cover, land use controls and long-term groundwater monitoring. Land use controls will be enacted to prohibit potable use of groundwater and prevent intrusive activities within the landfill boundary.

No significant immediate risk to human health or ecological receptors has been found at this site, but the proposed remedy will minimize the potential of any future impact. The Navy proposes to monitor groundwater quality until New Jersey Groundwater Quality Standards or background concentrations are achieved.

Public comments are encouraged at the meeting and written comments are also welcome. All significant comments and questions will be addressed in a Record of Decision which will be issued by the Navy and EPA to document the selected remedy. Written comments should be postmarked no later than June 12, 2009 and addressed to:
