The Navy's Installation Restoration (IR) program is an on going program established to investigate past hazardous materials operations and practices used at Navy activities. The goal of this program is to control and remediate any environmental problems that may or have resulted from these operations and practices. The Naval Weapons Station (NWS) Earle, Colts Neck, NJ currently has a IR study being contracted for by this office. Northern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command plans to establish a Technical Review Committee in accordance with the requirements of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986.

This committee will actively participate in the development of the scope of work for the Site Inspection (SI), the Remedial Investigation (RI) and the Feasibility Study (FS), provide comment and technical review during the execution of the SI, RI and FS, and assist in the selection of remedial technologies based on data gathered by the Navy's environmental consultant.

I would like to extend an invitation to your municipal engineer to serve as a committee member. Other members will include representatives the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), the Monmouth County Department of Health, Colts Neck Township, the Tinton Falls, the Township of Howell and Middletown Township. I anticipate that the committee will hold its first meeting early this Spring.
