Dear Mr. Goepfert:

This letter is being written to inform you that the Department has completed its review of the analytical data from the December 29, 1992 soil sampling event conducted in accordance with Section II, Condition 7(c) of your hazardous waste facility permit. The Bureau of Hazardous Waste Engineering's (Bureau) technical support group responsible for the review of the data has informed this Bureau that the data confirms the presence of beryllium, cadmium and lead in excess of Department residential direct contact soil cleanup criteria and beryllium and lead in excess of non-residential direct contact soil cleanup criteria.

Therefore, the Bureau has transferred this information to the Bureau of Site Assessment for integration into the Department's "Case Management Strategy" for assignment to the appropriate Bureau for any possible future Departmental actions regarding this area. This Bureau will not be the lead agency for any future actions involving this area. Furthermore, once this case has been assigned to the appropriate Bureau Naval Weapons Station Earle will be contacted by that Bureau.


