**June 24, 1995, Saturday**

**8:30 AM - All participants will meet at Building C-54. Transportation will be provided by Naval Weapons Station Earle to all sites within the main Station area. For those members who have not been on Station previously, please enter through the main gate (Colts Neck, NJ) off of Route 34 (about 1/2 mile south of the Route 34/Route 18 interchange). Building C-54 is located at the intersection of Esperance and Saipan Roads, about 1/4 mile from the main gate.**

**11:30 AM - 1:00 PM - Lunch (provided by Naval Weapons Station Earle)/Discussion**

**1:00 PM - 3:30 PM - Continue main Station tour.**

**3:45 PM - Tour concluded; return to Building C-54.**

**June 25, 1995, Sunday**

**1:30 PM - Entering through the Route 36 gate (Leonardo, NJ), all participants will meet in front of the "Pier 5 Club"; transportation will be provided by Naval Weapons Station Earle to all sites located at the "waterfront" area of the Station. The "Pier 5 Club" is located about 500 feet on your left upon passing through the Route 36 gate; parking is available across the street from the "Pier 5 Club."**


**3:30 PM - Tour concluded; return to "Pier 5 Club" (light refreshments).**
