Dear Commander Pylant:

As a result of the January 7, 1986 stream walking by Ms. Linda Grayson, it is the opinion of this Department that a total of eighteen (nine of each) surface water and sediment samples will be required to resample the East Branch of the Mingamahone Brook. In addition, two (2) field blanks (one for water and one for sediment) and one (1) trip blank will be needed.

As per our previous conversations, you had requested split samples be performed. If this is still your wish, I would appreciate your notifying me at your earliest convenience as to your lab selection. I recognize you are bound to specific funding and bidding procedures, as I am, and would like to schedule the sampling event for the last week of March.

I have attached Ms. Grayson's memo for your information.

I would like to thank you, once again, for the cooperation of your staff with regards to this matter. I look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
