Since the DEP mandated closure of the underground waste oil storage tank at Naval Weapons Station Earle, Colts Neck, NJ, the station has been forced to store waste oil in 55-gallon drums. This practice has caused difficulty in obtaining removal within the required 90-day period.

We are requesting DEP permission for construction of a 3000 gallon aboveground waste oil storage tank under interim status. Plans and specifications of the proposed tank can be found in the NWS Earle Part B application.
