

Dear Mr. Matthaey:

Enclosed please find two copies of the laboratory analysis data of the soil samples obtained from the location of the removed wastes oil tank. The tank was located adjacent to building C14. The samples were obtained on February 4, 1991. Denise Rude a representative of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) was present on-site during the sampling.

The samples were obtained in accordance with JACA's sampling plan dated August 10, 1990. However, Denis Rude initiated a deviation to the approved sample parameters of the subject plan. The parameter modifications required the analysis of PCB's and excluded the need for total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPHC) analysis. A description of the subject parameter modifications can be found within the letter submitted by DEP to your office on February 21, 1991. The subject letter is included as an attachment.

The laboratory analysis was performed by QC Inc., in accordance with the sampling plans quality control procedure. QC Inc., complied with DEP's parameter modifications. A copy of the sample data should be submitted to:
