Dear Sir:

On 90/05/09, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and Energy (the Department) received notification of a discharge of hazardous substances from your facility. On 90/08/02, the Department sent a letter to you along with a copy of the Scope of Work Document stating the requirements for the proper investigation and initiation of corrective action at your facility. A report documenting the steps you have taken to comply with our requirements was due on 90/12/02. As of this time, we have not received the required report.

The report must be submitted to the Department at the above address, within 10 days of the date of this letter, specifying all activities conducted in compliance with the Scope of Work Document.

Failure to respond to this letter in a complete and timely fashion may result in the assessment of penalties as provided for by law, pursuant to the Underground Storage of Hazardous Substances Act, N.J.S.A. 58:10A-21 et seq. Violators are liable for penalties of up to \$50,000 per day for each day of continuing violation.
