On January 29, 1993, the Department of Environmental Protection and Energy (the Department) received notification of a leaking 6,000 gallon ~~gasoline~~ ^{fuel oil} underground storage tank, at the above referenced facility. A CLOSURE APPROVAL IS BEING GRANTED.

Pursuant to the regulations entitled "Underground Storage Tank Systems Technical Requirements for Site Remediation," N.J.A.C. 7:26E, which were promulgated May 2, 1992, you are required to submit an "Underground Storage Tank Closure Plan Approval Application". Due to the urgent nature of this case, your closure approval is hereby granted contingent upon the following:

Your complete Closure Plan Approval Application must be submitted to the Department within five (5) days of the date of this letter, and must contain the proper fee, implementation schedule, decommissioning plan, and site assessment plan and registration.

If there are any changes to the emergency closure plan which was approved, you are required to notify in writing the case manager listed below as part of the Site Assessment Summary. This includes changes to the implementation schedule, additional UST systems previously unreported, and modifications to the site assessment plan for additional UST systems discovered. This information shall become a part of your existing closure file for review with the Site Assessment Summary.

Since you have obtained an Emergency Closure Approval, a

demolition permit authorized by the Department of Community Affairs (DCA), Construction Code Element must be procured from your local construction code official. Any work that is conducted at a site requires a demolition permit issued pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:23 et seq. For further information in obtaining a demolition permit, please contact the local construction code official directly, or DCA's Code Assistance Unit at (609) 530-8793.
