

This announces that an Action Memorandum, Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for the excavation and removal of pesticide and herbicide-impacted soils at the Naval Weapons Station Earle Former Pesticide Shop under the Navy's Installation Restoration Program has been drafted. The Northern Division of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, the lead agency for the site remedial activity, has recommended the removal of pesticide and herbicide impacted soils at the Former Pesticide Shop to minimize the potential for exposure and migration of the pesticides. This remedial action involves the demolition of the Former Pesticide Shop, the excavation, transportation, and off-site disposal of approximately 500 cubic yards of soils contaminated with pesticides and herbicides. 
