Dear Permittee:

The New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) General Groundwater Petroleum Product Clean-up (GPPC or B4B) Permit (NJ0102709) will expire on November 30, 1998. Therefore, your individual authorization to discharge under this B4B permit will also expire on November 30, 1998. If you plan to continue discharging beyond this date you must submit your renewal application at least 180 days before your authorization expires pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-4.2(e)3. If you do not plan to continue discharging after the permit expiration date listed above, please submit a written notice to:

If you do not submit a renewal application prior to the existing permit expiration date as indicated above and continue to discharge, you will be discharging without a permit and will be in violation of the New Jersey Water Pollution Control Act (N.J.S.A. 58:10A-1 et. seq.) and the NJPDES Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1 et. seq.).

Please note that a copy of the Request for Authorization Checklist for Category B4B and all forms necessary for a permit renewal application are attached for your convenience.

Please be advised that, as indicated in the enclosed application checklist for the B4B, the Department is hereby requiring sampling results from Methyl Tertiary-Butyl Ether (MTBE) and Tertiary Butyl Alcohol (TBA) analyses along with all of the other indicated pollutant analyses of the untreated wastewater. Applications that do not include analytical results from all of the required pollutant analyses, including but not limited to, MTBE and TBA, will be considered technically incomplete.
