Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Quality with the above-referenced report. The bioremediation project appears to have been successful in reducing the adsorbed phase contamination to a significant degree. Since the bioremediation project did not address the dissolved phase contamination, we will wait to review the results of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Remedial Investigation, currently in progress, before evaluating this site for closure. It is my understanding that this investigation should be complete in the summer of 1995. Please send the CERCLA Remedial Investigation Report for our review once it is complete. If we have not heard from you by September 30, 1995, this office will contact you for an update.
