Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) with the above-referenced report. In a letter dated August 21, 1994, DEQ required no further assessment or remedial action at this site. According to information in the Draft Work Plan, approximately 4,500 tons of petroleum contaminated soil will be excavated and thermally treated by off-site methods. The remediation time frame is April 17, 1995 through May 4, 1995. Normally, DEQ would require submittal of a corrective action plan before we could approve a remediation activity of this magnitude. However, because 1) the remediation plan is in compliance with the Army Corps of Engineers' Rapid Response Program, 2) a fully permitted thermal desorption unit will be utilized, 3) excavated soil will be properly stockpiled and sampled, and 4) confirmation analysis will be performed on samples collected from the excavation, we have no objection to your proceeding with the proposed cleanup. Please send us a copy of the final report for review, once it is complete.
