Re: Request for Information, Former Landfill-Fort Story Army Base, Virginia Beach

Dear Mr. McCall:

During a review of an Environmental Impact Study conducted for the Ft. Story Army Base in Virginia Beach, information was presented that made mention of a landfill being located in the approximate area of the proposed AT & T Wireless Service Telecommunication facility. According to information contained within the report, the landfill is located along Coast Artillery Road near the old main gate approximately three hundred feet from the proposed telecommunication facility. The study mentions a 1995 sampling program conducted at the landfill that revealed soil and groundwater contamination were present around the landfill.

The Department is not aware of the presence of a landfill at this location, therefore we are requesting whatever information you have concerning the landfill be submitted to the Department for review. The information will aide in the determination of the need for additional investigation and/or the potential risk the unpermitted area may have on human health and the environment. The information should include at a minimum any environmental assessments and/or sampling information, a description of material allegedly disposed at this location, when the material allegedly was disposed as well any statements made by witnesses regarding the material. Under Virginia Code 10.1-1402(6), the Waste Management Board is authorized to collect data necessary to conduct state waste programs, including data on the identification of and amounts of waste generated stored, treated or disposed.
