As I mentioned earlier today, Robert Weld from my office has reviewed the DD and still has some concerns about the Auto Craft Site. In particular, he is very concerned about the hazard index for chloroform and manganese being greater than 1. I suggest a conference call or meeting with Malcolm Pirnie to get additional information to explain the risks away. Some issues we may want to explore are:

- \* Is the data valid for chloroform or could it be lab error?
- \* Was there only one hit or has it been there in multiple sampling events and; if so, are the levels decreasing over time?
- \* Where could it have originated from?
- \* What are the background levels of manganese at the site?
