the Cleanup Plan for the  
LARC 60 Maintenance Area,  
Fort Story and Announces a  
Public Meeting and Project  
Presentation**

The Fort Eustis environmental office along with the Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) will be holding a Public Meeting to discuss the Remedial Investigation (RI) and RI Addendum reports and the Proposed Plan to be considered for the clean up of the LARC 60 Maintenance Area Site, Fort Story, Virginia. The RI and RI Addendum reports discuss the risk posed by the site and present an evaluation of cleanup options. The Proposed Plan identifies the preferred cleanup action set forth for public comment.

Fort Eustis evaluated the LARC 60 Maintenance Area Site. No potential unacceptable human health or ecological risks have been identified for the site, and the latest groundwater sampling event, conducted in May 2007, did not result in any exceedances of the Environmental Protection Agency's Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs). Therefore, a Feasibility Study (FS) was not conducted. Accordingly, an evaluation of potential remedial alternatives was not available. Although a preferred alternative was not identified through the typical FS alternatives analysis, the proposed remedy for the site is No Further Action because of the lack of identified potential risk at the site.

Based on available information, the preferred option proposed for public comment at this time is for **No Further Action**. Although this is the preferred Alternative at the present time, Fort Eustis welcomes the public's comments on all of the information listed above. The formal comment period begins September 8, 2007 and ends October 7, 2007. Fort Eustis will choose the final remedy after the comment period ends and may select a different cleanup approach after taking public comments into account.
