You are hereby directed to continue with the following change to your contract identified as M-8168 entitled "Site Contamination":

1. Overexcavate as required to remove all the contaminated soil (greater than 50 ppm petroleum) from the tank graves in excess of the 180 CY required by the contract.
2. Remove and dispose of all excavated contaminated (greater than 50 ppm) soils in excess of 425 CY required by the contract.
3. Provide the necessary backfill material for the overexcavation operation in excess of the 225 CY required by the contract.
4. If, after you have overexcavated a tank grave and your analysis shows greater than 50 ppm, continue to overexcavate until the analysis shows less than 50 ppm. Perform any tests required to verify the soil contamination is less than 50 ppm.

Do not exceed \$50,000.00 in additional costs. The total additional work to date you have been directed to perform *for this change* is \$106,000.00; \$56,000.00 on December 9, 1992 and \$50,000.00 via this letter. Notify me immediately, in writing, if you anticipate exceeding \$50,000.00 in additional costs.

Please provide a detailed proposal for the entire modification by February 1, 1993, as outlined by Contract Clause 81 entitled "Modification Proposals - Price Breakdown". The price breakdown shall include unit costs for the described work as labeled in the original bid schedule. Provide back-up documentation for any associated laboratory and impact costs.
