Invites Public Comment on Site Closure
for the 80th Division Reserve Site at
Fort Story, Virginia

The Fort Eustis environmental office is seeking public comments on the site closure plan for one site at Fort Story, Virginia. A Draft Final Decision Document has been prepared for the 80th Division Reserve Site which presents the Selected Remedy (Land Use Controls (LUCs) with Monitoring). The Selected Remedy (LUCs with Monitoring) was chosen in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, and the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan. The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the Draft Final Decision Document, and with the Army, jointly selects the remedy in accordance with CERCLA.

LUCs with monitoring are necessary at the Site because trichloroethene (TCE) and tetrachloroethene (PCE) have exceeded the US Environmental Protection Agency's maximum contaminant levels (MCLs). However, at present, there is limited contamination detected at the site, trends indicate that concentrations in groundwater are decreasing due to natural mechanisms, and the results of the baseline risk assessment indicate that there are no potentially exposed populations. In addition, there is no current or planned use of groundwater as a potable water source. Therefore, with the implementation of the LUCs prohibiting groundwater use, monitoring of the groundwater for volatile organic carbons (VOCs) is only required once every five years as part of the five-year review of the site status. Following the monitoring event, if the VOC concentrations are below the MCLs, then a confirmation sampling event will be conducted three and six months later to confirm that concentrations are below MCLs. If confirmed, then removal of the LUCs will be warranted. If MCL exceedences remain, then the LUCs will remain in-place and the monitoring will continue every five years until VOC concentrations decrease to below the MCLs.

Fort Eustis welcomes the public's comments on the Draft Final Decision Document. The formal comment period ends **June 6.**
