Dear Mr. Cabiness:

In reviewing the Technical Review Committee meeting No. 23 minutes of November 17, 1994, I noted one item which I believe specifically should be corrected. On page 7 item No. F.5, the last sentence of the first paragraph I believe should be deleted. "He said the city has apparently retreated from previous statements made regarding resolution of this issue." The City is very interested in receiving the remedial water from the NIROP site. I do not understand the phrase as written and believe it was written out of context with some of the discussion at the meeting. Therefore, it would more clearly define the City's position by deleting it from the minutes.

Page 2 item No. 6 - The City is interested in receiving the O&M Manual in regard to the facility. Request a copy be provided.

Page 3 item No. 8 - I believe there is considerable confusion regarding the glacial drift and the Prairie du Chien/Jordan aquifer. Therefore, I think it would be clearer for the record to indicate which aquifer is being discussed and should be noted in the minutes as well as all future discussions.

Page 7 item No. 7 - The City is also interested in receiving a copy of the VOC plume and the location of the two new extraction wells. This, I believe, has some impact on the remedial action plan and the City's position regarding the conservation of the aquifer.

Request the appropriate changes be incorporated into the minutes and copies of the requested documents be provided.
