Dave, John & Paul:

I just talked to Kerry Morrow about Navy's desire to get on with the sampling of the East Plating Room soils.

The "window of opportunity" for sampling of these soils has apparently narrowed considerably. You may recall that we were told at the last TRC meeting that we had until August of this year to get our sampling done. It appears that the project is being accelerated, so that we now have until the end of March to get the samples, with the area scheduled for backfilling and construction in mid-April. Kerry also said that they were intending to sample the west plating room.

Haliburton will be at the plant the 13th and 14th of Feb to get information on the sampling effort. Kerry wondered if we could make it at 10:00 on the 14th to meet and discuss our requirements and desires for sample collection. Paul and I are planning on going - John, do you want to be involved? We could use your perspective . . .

I told him that our major concerns would be that the QAPP was followed, and that the locations of the soil borings accurately reflected the areas most likely to show contamination. He said that we should have access to the pits where the tanks are/were located.

He told me that he had been in Washington (?) and gotten the word that they want to start investigating OU3 in earnest. This includes intentions to sample not only the plating room areas, but to get samples under the office areas and TRC meeting room. I want to make clear to him on the 14th that these efforts should be preceded by workplans and a clear schedule for activities, review times, responsibilities, etc. so that we don't get into the same old pickle as before.

I would like to make sure that Mr. Bloom is on the same wavelength as us with respect to the sampling plan for the plating rooms.
