The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is requesting a 28 day extension for submitting agency comments to the Feasibility Study for Soils Operable Unit, Naval Industrial Reserve Ordnance Plant, Fridley, MN, April 1995. The previous date of June 23, 1995, would be extended to July 21, 1995. The main reason for the request for extension is that conclusions in the Feasibility Study for the Soils Operable Unit do not incorporate the agreed upon strategy discussed during the soils operable unit scoping process. Additional time to compose review comments to reflect incorporation of agreed upon strategy, is needed. After FS review comments are issued, U.S. EPA will propose a face-to-face meeting to explain and discuss review comments.
