Pursuant to your telephone request on May 1, 2000, enclosed are maps depicting the groundwater sampling point locations, groundwater contours and preliminary groundwater analytical results on United Defense, L.P. property. The samples were collected as part of the RCRA Corrective Action Work Plan. I have also enclosed copies of the soil borings where the temporary or permanent wells were installed. My understanding is that this information is necessary to assist in determining the appropriate location for another Navy extraction well to contain high levels of TCE contamination in the intermediate depth of the surficial aquifer downgradient from Navy Well 33-I.

As the maps indicate, this data is preliminary and should be viewed in this light. Because of delays in gaining access to Burlington Northern Sante Fe property, the final report is planned for submittal in late June or July.
