Subject: NIROP Groundwater Contamination

Dear Mr. Douglas:

The City has received a copy of the 1994 analysis of the Commons Park groundwater contamination study from Bruce A. Liesch. A copy is being sent to you directly.

This year's study compliments the past years reports indicating that the contamination experienced in the four City wells at the Commons Park well field are possibly drawing contamination from the southwest into its area of influence. In the past, we had assumed that the contamination was possibly flowing in a normal direction from the northeast to the southwest and addressing the TCAAP site. The information we have received from the MPCA strongly supports the fact that the TCAAP is not a contributor to the Commons Park problem. The City has never received information regarding southern contamination sites, therefore, we believe that a study has never been completed investigating the possibility of the NIROP/FMC site contributing to the Commons Park contamination.

Request an analysis be made to determine what, if any, effect the NIROP/FMC contamination can be contributing to the Commons Park well field. If you require any additional information you may contact Jim DeLambert of Bruce A. Liesch & Associates at 559-1423 or myself at 571-3550.
