The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA or Agency) is in receipt of the Navy's *Final Focused Feasibility Study Site 5 – Transformer Storage Boneyard, Site 9 – Camp Moffett Ravine Fill Area, and Site 21 – Buildings 1517/1506 Area, Naval Station Great Lakes, Great Lakes, Illinois*. It was dated October 2013 and was received via electronic mail at the Agency on November 12, 2013. The FFS presents the development and evaluation of remedial alternatives for current and hypothetical future land use activities at these three sites. 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
