The Agency has conducted a review of the submittal and has generated the following comments.

- 1) Figure 2-3 - This figure is relatively small and difficult to read. Suggest enlarging the figure to at least 11 x 17 so that all of the provided information is legible.
- 2) Section 2.6 - In the last full sentence on page 12, it states "...however recreational users are not likely, due to limited fish activity, and lack of attractiveness as a recreational area." Suggest rewording this statement as it is rather ambiguous.
- 3) Figure 2-4 - This figure needs a note similar to the one on the following figure that states the sampling locations are shown north to south (upstream to downstream).
- 4) Section 3.0 - Suggest re-wording the second sentence as follows: The Navy did not receive a request for a public meeting and no comments or questions were received during the designated public comment period.
- 5) List of Acronyms and Abbreviations - The use of capital letters in the definitions is inconsistent. Please review and revise as necessary.
