On behalf of the Navy, please find enclosed three copies of the technical memorandum regarding the facility-wide groundwater classification at Naval Station (NAVSTA) Great Lakes, Illinois. The evaluation presented in this technical memorandum concludes that the groundwater at NAVSTA Great Lakes does not meet the requirements of 35 IAC Part 620.210 as Class I. Therefore, it is requested that shallow groundwater in Quaternary sediments overlying Silurian bedrock within NAVSTA Great Lakes and situated on the level plain atop the bluff west of the shoreline along Lake Michigan at elevations of approximately 650 feet or higher, be considered eligible for reclassification as Class II: General Resource Groundwater.
