PUBLIC NOTICE Notice of Availability Record of Decision [Site 19](#) Small Arms Range 910 Naval Station Great Lakes The Record of Decision (ROD) for the Naval Station Great Lakes [Site 19](#) Small Arms Range 910 has been issued by the Navy, as the lead agency, with concurrence by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA). The ROD documents the Navy's selected remedy, Land Use Controls. The selected remedy is protective of human health and the environment and is intended to be the final action at [Site 19](#). After reviewing several possible cleanup options, Navy and Illinois EPA selected Land Use Controls for the final remedial action. Land use controls will be incorporated into the Base Master Plan to make sure that the restrictions on land use and excavation/disturbance are applied and enforced at the site. The land use controls will prohibit residential and special non-residential (such as for child-care facilities, pre-schools, elementary schools, secondary schools, playgrounds, convalescent, or nursing care facilities) reuse of the site and prohibit excavation and disturbance of the surface and subsurface soil. The Proposed Plan outlined the selected remedy and underwent a 30-day public comment period in June/July 2013. The ROD was signed by the Navy on February 6, 2014, with the Illinois EPA providing its concurrence on April 17, 2014. This announcement is being made in accordance with the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan; 40 CFR Part 300.430(f)(6).
