This cause coming on to be heard upon the petition and motion of the United States of America, by J. Albert Woll, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois, and it appearing to the Court that this proceeding has been instituted at the request of the Acting Secretary of the Navy, acting pursuant to the provisions of the Second War Powers Act, 1942 (Public Law 507 - 77th Congress), and under direction of the Attorney General, and that all owner-occupants and other persons interested in the real estate, or some part or parts thereof, have been made parties defendant hereto, and the Court being advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the real property described as follows:


Starting at a point on the north-south center line of Section 6, Township 44 North, Range 12, East of the 3rd Principal Meridian, at the northwest corner of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 6; thence east a distance of approximately 2949 feet to the center line of Green Bay

Road, located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 5; thence on a line southeasterly on the center line of Green Bay Road, passing through the Southwest Quarter of Section 5, the West Half of Section 8 and the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, to the north line of the right-of-way of the E. J. & E. Railroad; thence on a line southwesterly on the north line of the right-of-way of the E. J. & E. Railroad, through the West Half of Section 17 and the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, to the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois; thence on the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois, in a northwesterly direction, through the East Half of Section 18 and the East Half of Section 7 to the intersection of this line with the north-south center line of Section 7; thence north on the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois, on the north-south center line of Sections 7 and 6, to the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, which is the point of beginning, located in Shields' Township, in Lake County, Illinois, containing a total of 685.2 acres, more or less.

be and hereby is condemned and taken by the United States of America for naval and other war purposes, and the United States of America, its duly authorized officers and employees shall have the right to take immediate possession, occupy, use and improve said real estate, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Marshal shall forthwith serve a copy of this order upon each of the defendants named in the Petition for Condemnation and upon every person found to be in possession of or upon said real property.

AMENDMENT TO PETITION FOR CONDEMNATION.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF ILLINOIS:

Now comes the United States of America, petitioner herein, by its attorney, J. ALBERT WOLL, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois, at the direction of and on behalf of the Attorney General of the United States of America, and leave of Court having been first obtained, files this, its Amendment to the Petition for Condemnation herein, and respectfully represents unto the Court as follows:

I.

That the real property which the Acting Secretary of the Navy has deemed necessary to be acquired in fee simple, subject to public utility and drainage district easements, is amended to read:

Starting at a point on the North-South center line of Section 6, Township 44 North, Range 12, East of the 3rd Principal Meridian, at the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 6; thence east a distance of approximately 2949 feet to the center line of Green Bay Road, located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 5; thence on a line southeasterly on the center

line of Green Bay Road, passing through the Southwest Quarter of Section 5, the West Half of Section 8 and the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, to the north line of the right-of-way of the E. J. & E. Railroad; thence on a line southwesterly on the north line of the right-of-way of the E. J. & E. Railroad, through the West Half of Section 17 and the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, to the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois; thence on the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois, in a northwesterly direction, through the East Half of Section 18 and the East Half of Section 7 to the intersection of this line with the north-south center line of Section 7; thence north on the east line of the right-of-way of the Public Service Co. of Northern Illinois, on the north-south center line of Sections 7 and 6, to the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, which is the point of beginning, located in Shields' Township, in Lake County, Illinois, containing a total of 685.2 acres, more or less, and subject to the rights of the public to use Patricia Avenue, Green Bay Road, and the right-of-way of the public highway known as Buckley Road, as indicated on the right-of-way plat filed in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, Illinois, on March 15, 1933, in Book W of Plats, on Pages 72 and 73, as Document No. 389523; and excepting therefrom that part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 44 North, Range 12, East of the 3rd Principal Meridian, described as follows, To Wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Quarter Section; thence East along the North line thereof to the Northwesterly line of the right-of-way of the E. J. & E. Railroad; thence Southwesterly along the Northwesterly line of said right-of-way to the West line of said Quarter Section; thence North along the said West line to the place of beginning, in Lake County, Illinois.

II.

That part of the real property described in Paragraph I is composed of lots and blocks and adjacent streets and alleys described as:

All of blocks 1 to 19 in Frederick H. Bartlett's Lake View Estates, being a subdivision in Sections 5 and 6, Township 44 North, Range 12, East of the 3rd P. M., according to the plat thereof, recorded October 15, 1925, as Document 267110, in Book "O" of Plats, Pages 74 and 75, together with adjacent streets and alleys, all in Lake County, Illinois

and that said blocks are divided into parcels, apparently owned and described as follows:


