As required by CERCLA, a Proposed Plan outlined the selected remedy and underwent a 30-day public comment period from March 14 to April 14, 2014. The selected remedy for these three sites calls for Land Use Controls (LUCs), annual site inspections, and Five Year Reviews. LUCs will restrict groundwater and surface water use, will restrict disturbance of surface and subsurface soil, and prohibit residential development. These LUCs will be incorporated into the Base Master Plan to ensure that the restrictions and prohibitions are applied and enforced at the sites. While LUCs are in-place, annual inspections and Five Year Review will be necessary. 
