The Navy and Tetra Tech received Illinois EPA's November 9, 2015 comments on the draft Site 12 Proposed Plan and prepared the attached response-to-comment (RTC) document in response. A draft final version of the Proposed Plan was also prepared that captures the changes recommended in the RTC document. Both the RTC document and revised Proposed Plan are attached to this email for your review and concurrence. The changes to the Proposed Plan are captured in red text.

After Illinois EPA concurrence is received, the Proposed Plan will be finalized (draft final removed from header, red text changed to black text, etc.) and the Public Notice will be prepared. I anticipate that the Public Notice will run in local papers in mid-January 2016 because of the public comment period beginning February 1, 2016. Tetra Tech will also be submitting the draft Record of Decision to Illinois EPA for review by December 11, 2015. The ROD will be finalized after the public comment period ends (March 1, 2016) and any comments that are received are resolved.
