For your informatin, Tim is not averaging the sampling results. He is reporting the maximum concentration of the two sampling events for the permit parameters. Deborah is saying that the form does not allow for reporting each sample result for each parameter (when two sampling events are required per month - an atypical samping frequency for most NPDES permits), but that the Navy must report each sampling result for each sampling event. Tim told me that he would talk to Deborah directly and find a way to report each sampling result for each sampling event. Dave
