The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA or Agency) is in receipt of the submitted *Focused Feasibility Study Report for Site 1 - Golf Course Landfill and Site 4 - Fire Fighting Training Unit, Naval Station Great Lakes*. The report was drafted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. on behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command Midwest (Navy). It was dated January 2009 and was received at the Agency on February 6, 2009. The purpose of the Focused Feasibility Study (FS) is to develop and evaluate options for the final remedial action for Site 1 - Golf Course Landfill (aka Willow Glen Golf Course) and Site 4 - Fire Fighting Training Unit (FFTU).

Illinois EPA received a draft version of this report on June 5, 2008 and provided a comment letter on July 24, 2008. The Navy submitted responses to Agency comments via electronic mail and subsequent e-mails allowed a few minor remaining issues to be ironed out. The Agency has now conducted a review of the Navy's final report and verified that the proposed revisions have been incorporated into the final document. The Agency has nothing further to add. Therefore, Illinois EPA can now concur with the contents of the submittal as written. As requested, Agency personnel have signed the appropriate page and are herein returning said page for inclusion in the final document.




