

**Notice of Public Comment Period on Proposed Plan for a former Silk Screening Shop at RTC Great Lakes**

The Navy, as part of its responsibilities under the Installation Restoration (IR) Program, has completed a Proposed Plan for Site 7, the former RTC Silk Screening Shop, at NTC Great Lakes. The Proposed Plan is a document that summarizes the final decision on how to protect the community after considering and addressing the public comments. The Proposed Plan for the site, as developed by the Navy, recommends No Further Action (NFA). For the site, the investigation recommended the excavation and offsite disposal of contaminated soil as the method for removal of a source of contamination.

As a result of past operating practices, contaminants were found in soil at the site. The main soil contaminants included polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), and approximately 48.5 tons of contaminated soil were excavated and disposed offsite as part of a hot spot removal action. The hot spot removal action conducted at the site was protective of human health and the environment and was conducted to meet cleanup standards that allow unrestricted reuse of the sites. The Navy and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) concur with the proposed clean-up plan for Site 7.

The public is encouraged to review and comment on the U.S. Navy's Proposed Plans. A public comment period for the Proposed Plan for Site 7 is scheduled from March 1 through March 30, 2003. Comments may be written or verbal. Written comments should be submitted to the address listed below. Comments must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2003.
