Dear Mr. Schultz:

This is in response to E. M. Morrison's letter dated October 5, 1994 which was received by the Agency on October 11, 1994. This letter requested an extension from the October 1, 1994 deadline for the completion of closure activities and the December 1, 1994 deadline for the submission of the closure certification for the closure of the five hazardous waste container storage areas (S01) undergoing RCRA closure at the above-referenced facility. These units are as follows:

Building 105: Former Laundry S01 Area
Building 145: S01 Area
Building 415: Navy Exchange S01 Area
Building 520: Service School Command S01 Area
Building 912: Navy Resale Activity Laundry S01 Area

This submittal is hereby approved subject to the following conditions and modifications:

1. Closure activities should be completed by October 1, 1995. The revised tentative date for the submittal of the closure documentation report is December 1, 1995. These dates may be revised if Great Lakes Naval Training Center ("GLNTC") finds that additional time is necessary to complete all required closure activities and demonstrates to the Agency that it is attempting to complete closure in a timely manner.
2. Item I of the estimated completion schedule (as presented in the subject submittal) is a meeting between representatives of the Department of the Navy and the Agency on April 21, 1995. The Agency feels that it is premature to schedule a meeting at this time concerning the results of the field activities. Instead, a draft report documenting the results of the additional soil sampling/analysis report should be submitted to the Agency for review and comments by May 1, 1995 and, depending on

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the results of this review, either a phone conference or a meeting between representatives of GLNTC and the Agency should be scheduled at that time.

3. Except as modified by this letter, closure activities should be conducted in accordance with this Agency's March 29, 1994 closure plan approval letter (C-689).
