The Navy Environmental Restoration Program invites public comment on the Proposed Plan for remedial action at Environmental Restoration Site 11a, Building 3033 Former Vehicle Repair Facility and Waste Oil Tank, at Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek, located in Virginia Beach, Virginia. This Proposed Plan identifies and discusses the preferred alternative to address contamination that has occurred as a result of a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) release.

As per the Code of Federal Regulations, 40 C.F.R. §300.430(f)(2), the Proposed Plan presents assessments of risk to human health and the environment, along with a summary of remedial alternatives considered for Site 11a. The preferred remedial alternative outlined in the Proposed Plan is groundwater treatment, through Enhanced Reductive Dechlorination and land use controls. Land use controls are to be maintained until site conditions allow for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 11a, as well remedial investigations conducted at the site.
