The purpose of this letter is to update you on the status of the NAB Little Creek Installation Restoration (IR) Program and the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB).

Since our last meeting in June, we have been compiling and addressing comments from various regulatory agencies regarding the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) and Site Investigation (SI). We have finalized the Corrective Measures Plan (CMP) for the Site 16 (Pole #425 PCB Spill) cleanup action and the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis study for the Site 11 (Former School of Music Plating Shop and Neutralization Tank) removal action. We anticipate that the Site 16 and 11 Removal Actions will commence by November 1994. Additionally, the Navy's environmental contractors have been tasked with developing a Site Management Plan (SMP). The purpose of the SMP is to present projected activities and ensure consistency with long-term IR program goals. The SMP will document decisions made during project planning and will include target dates for projected actions.

The RAB meeting originally scheduled for September 1994 will be postponed until late October or early November so that the draft SMP and comments on the last round of studies will be available for discussion. 
