One of the topics discussed during the recent Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting held on November 22, 1994, was RAB responsibilities and organization. The Navy's guidance concerning RABs states that a Community Co-Chair position should be established. Although many of the Community Co-Chair's responsibilities mirror that of individual RAB member responsibilities, the attending RAB members felt that the Community Co-Chair position was necessary and should be established. The Community Co-Chair represents non-Navy and non-regulatory stakeholders on the RAB, and provides the necessary link to the RAB for any members of the community with concerns or interest regarding NAB Little Creek's restoration program.

It is NAB Little Creek's position that the non-Navy RAB members should nominate and select the person to hold the Community Co-Chair position. Also, the duration of the Community Co-Chair's term should be decided by the non-Navy RAB members. The term limits will be discussed at the next RAB meeting.

Mr. Robert Deegan nominated Mr. Walter Vargo for the Community Co-Chair position since he was selected as the Virginia Beach Mayor's Representative for the predecessor to the RAB, the Technical Review Committee (TRC). No attending RAB members opposed Mr. Vargo's nomination as Community Co-Chair.

We are contacting all RAB members who could not attend the November 22, 1994, meeting to inform them of the Community Co-Chair discussion and nomination of Mr. Vargo. If you have any questions or comments regarding the Community Co-Chair position or nomination, please contact Mr. Richard Stryker (Navy Co-Chair) at 363-4571 by December 30, 1994. Absent any objections or nominations, we will designate Mr Vargo as the RAB Community Co-Chair.
