In accordance with the guidelines established for the Navy's Installation Restoration (IR) Program, the Department of the Navy invites public participation at the Public/Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting. The meeting will be held to report progress on the IR Program and other environmental issues at NAB Little Creek. The RAB meeting will take place Tuesday, February 10, 1998 at 1:00 pm at the Drexler Manor BOQ, Building 3408, in the third floor Blue Heron Conference Room on NAB Little Creek. Parking will be available in the BOQ residents' lot.

The Navy also seeks to inform the public of the availability of the Final Decision Document (DD) for Site 7. The DD outlines the selected remedial action for Site 7. This action was selected after input from the public and state and federal regulatory agencies.
