The Navy Installation Restoration Program invites public comment on its Proposed Plan for remedial action at Installation Restoration Site 11, the Former School of Music Plating Shop, at Naval Amphibious Base, Little Creek, located in Virginia Beach, Virginia. As per 40 C.F.R. § 300.430(f)(2), the Proposed Plan presents assessments of risk to human health and the environment, along with a summary of remedial alternatives considered for Site 11. The preferred remedial alternative outlined in the Proposed Plan is groundwater treatment through Enhanced Reductive Dechlorination, and performance monitoring. Land use controls are also proposed for the site, to be maintained until site conditions allow for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for Naval Amphibious Base, Little Creek. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 11, as well remedial investigations conducted at the site.
