As per our conference call yesterday regarding comments on the Draft Final FS, EPA has considered the Navy's verbal responses and suggests resolution of the comments noted below as indicated:

1. Delete "for human consumption" from the 3 text sections noted.
4. No FS revisions needed.
6. No FS revisions needed.

47-49. Navy should consider these comments. If Navy issues a written response that they have considered the comments and that revisions to address the questions and/or discrepancies noted will not significantly change the costs and quantities calculated and thus would not change the remedy selection decision, EPA will accept that response and will not require that revisions to the Appendices be made in the Final FS. Navy should also respond that the questions and/or discrepancies noted will be addressed, as appropriate, in the Remedial Design.

50. Navy should revise the FS to reflect a more conservative remediation duration estimate for the mobilized metals, as discussed. EPA would be willing to accept the FS as is on this matter, but it must be modified for the ROD.

Once the Navy's legal counsel considers the ARARs comments, let me know if a follow-on conference call is warranted. I remain willing to make the ARARs changes to the ARARs tables in the document (via redline/strikeout), once Navy legal agrees in principle with the proposed revisions.

If there is an action-item from the call that I have missed, please let me know. Thanks.
