On behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC), Mid-Atlantic (MIDLANT), Resolution Consultants is pleased to provide this draft Feasibility Study (FS) Report for the sediment at MRP Site 1.

This draft FS was prepared utilizing the existing data collected during the prior Site Investigation and Remedial Investigation efforts. Other important considerations are:

1. The remedial action objective for pellets in sediment is based on the prior discussions and information reviewed with the regulatory agencies, included review by the EPA's ecological risk assessment support staff.
2. The area of sediment impact at the adjacent Site 22, co-located with sediment impacted with lead pellets from MRP Site 1, is included in this FS per prior discussions with the team including the January 2016 RPM meeting.
3. This FS is for the sediment portion of the site only. A separate FS is forthcoming for the soil and groundwater at the upland site area.

Note that the Navy requests a meeting to discuss the FS components in more detail at your soonest convenience. Please let me know of your availability the week of May 9th for such a discussion along with preliminary questions and answers dialogue.
