On behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC), Mid-Atlantic (MIDLANT), Resolution Consultants is pleased to provide this draft Feasibility Study (FS) Report for Site 22.

This draft FS was prepared utilizing the existing data collected during the prior Site Investigation and Remedial Investigation efforts. Other important considerations are:

1. It is understood that additional groundwater data collection will continue during the FS/PP/ROD process and that the remedies included are reasonable for consideration, but may be modified depending on the assessment of potential upgradient impacts. For instance, the future groundwater remedy may become part of another site for efficiency.
2. Additional soil data (PDI) will be utilized where appropriate to refine extents of impact in localized areas.
3. There is a site-specific background memorandum attached to the FS, as discussed in prior meetings, and utilized in this FS to support PRG development.
4. The sediment impacted at Site 22 is discussed in this FS, but the development of remedial alternatives will be included the MRP Site 1 FS because the area is co-located with lead-pellets that originated from MRP Site 1. This approach was agreed to in the January RPM meeting.

Note that the Navy requests a meeting to discuss the FS components in more detail at your soonest convenience. Please let me know of your availability the week of May 2nd for such a discussion along with preliminary questions and answers dialogue.
