Gentlemen:

In our letter dated 28 September 1989 we informed you of our plans to abandon CT DEP Tank #NN01. We are forwarding this letter to inform you that Naval Submarine Base New London has terminated the contract for abandonment of OT #5 (CT DEP #NN01) due to discovery of PCBs. PCBs were found in sediments, oil, and water in the bottom one foot of the tank.

Northern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania is negotiating a new contract to design the closure. We expect design completion by October 1991 with construction to start in the spring of 1992 and abandonment completed by October 1992.

In the meantime, all work has stopped and the PCB contaminated materials remain in OT #5, which has been sealed. Any questions concerning this matter should be directed to Mr. James Fitzpatrick at (203) 449-3180.
