SUBJECT: NAVAL BASE, NORFOLK FEDERAL FACILITIES AGREEMENT

During a April 23, 1998 meeting between the Navy and your office, an agreement to place Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) #37 in the *Finding of Fact* Section of the Federal Facilities Agreement for Naval Base, Norfolk (NBN) was reached. During this meeting, the Navy was tasked to provide documentation of the current remediation project at SWMU #37.

Staining of the pavement in the vicinity of the Navy Public Works Center, Norfolk (PWC) fueling and parking area was noted during the Environmental Protection Agency's Environmental Photographic Interpretation Center (EPIC) study of archived aerial photography of NBN. The final EPIC report identified this stained area as Waste Disposal Area (WDA) #2. The Navy refers to WDA #2 as SWMU #37. A former fueling depot, Building Q-65, was located in this area.

The remediation of this site is being conducted in accordance with the Virginia Underground Storage Tank Regulations per enclosures (1) through (3). The remediation system includes all contamination detected during the site characterization. The three underground storage tanks at the Q-65 fueling depot were removed in 1995, as documented by enclosure (4).
