RJ/RFI Work Plan Addendum, Site 12/SWMU 10, Jericho Island Disposal Area
(November 1999)

The Division of Hydrogeology has reviewed the Document listed above. This document (dated 12 November 1999) was received on 15 November 1999. It has been submitted as an addendum to the Remedial Investigation/RCRA Facility Investigation Work Plan for Site 12/SWMU 10, Jericho Island Disposal Area, dated April 1998. This addendum provides a physical description of Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 10 that includes a brief history of SWMU 10. It briefly describes previous studies performed at SWMU 10 and indicates that the previous studies suffer from data gaps. This work plan addendum proposes the sample strategy necessary to fill the data gaps in order to delineate the nature and extent of contamination at SWMU 10.

This document was reviewed with respect to R.61-79 of the South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (SCHWMR), and appropriate guidance documents. Based on this review, the Division of Hydrogeology has determined that this work plan addendum accurately incorporates previous discussions that the Tier I team had concerning SWMU 10. It is therefore recommended that this RJ/RFI Work Plan Addendum can be approved and implemented as written.

Status of remnant drinking water well on Jericho Island (SWMU 10)

In light of the recent review of the RI/RFI Work Plan Addendum, Site 12/SWMU 10, Jericho Island Disposal Area (Memorandum, Hargrove to Stamps, 2 December, 1999), the following point should be brought to the attention of MCRD:

Review of the DRAFT Remedial Investigation/RCRA Facility Investigation Work Plan for Site 12/SWMU 10, Jericho Island Disposal Area, dated April 1998, generated a comment concerning a "remnant drinking water well." The comment, as written, is listed below:

- 2) This work plan specifies that a remnant drinking water well is located on this currently uninhabited island. This well should be immediately abandoned according to R.61-71 of the South Carolina Well Standards and Regulations. No revision to the document is necessary.
(Memorandum: Hargrove to Peterson, 5 May, 1998)

This letter serves as a reminder that this well should have already been abandoned during the well drilling activities taking place during the above work plan. Additionally, DHEC Form 1903 should have been submitted to the Department describing the location of the well, method of abandonment, as well as the name and Certification number of the Driller who abandoned this well.

What is the status of this well? If it has already been abandoned, has the Form 1903 been submitted yet? If the answer to either of these questions is no, then preparations should be made to abandon this well during the implementation of the next phase of investigation at SWMU 10 (Appendix C, RI/RFI Addendum).
