
General Comments

Proposed Clean-Up plan seems well thought-out and well developed. Of options considered, I would prefer Alternative 3 which would completely remove all contaminated sediments from the site. However, it should be realized that under Alternative 3, land disturbance from the extensive excavation could well release more contaminants into the marine environment than the other options.

Therefore, I see your proposal for Modified Alternative 2a as a reasonable and the most practical solution for clean-up of the site, if, as found in your analyses that arsenic concentrations at the site pose no threat. This alternative provides for excavation and consolidation, with containment under a cap system, along with erosion control, tidal marsh restoration, long-term monitoring and maintenance, and land-use controls.

Modified plan 2a assumes that containment will be effective, and for this plan to meet objectives, post-project monitoring must be focused on assuring success of the containment system, through addressing (1) "trigger" criteria that could be used to identify system failure, and (2) contingency actions to be taken in the event of such failure.
