Good morning Meredith and Joe - As I may have mentioned, our field crew who will work at Parris Island is currently across town at MCAS Beaufort. That work is advancing at a better than expected pace, and the crew may find that they can start at Parris Island early next week. I am accelerating our effort to finalize the WP, but I do not think there were any outstanding issues with SCDHEC in any case. Therefore, is it possible that I can now get Monitoring Well Approval for the temporary wells at this site (the permanent wells will come later, and I'll follow up with a separate request). For the temporary wells, we expect the following (23 total).

eleven shallow TWs to approximately 12 feet bgs
twelve intermediate depth TWs to approximately 24 feet bgs

We are not expecting that these wells penetrate any confining units.

If possible, please consider adding an additional two wells (to 25 total) to the Approval, to address any unforeseen need identified in the field. Thanks.
