As I was going back over the SI/CS paper trail, I did find that Stacey sent us roughed-out replies in June 2003 to the comments I originally sent with this note. But many of the SCDHEC replies resulted in us having additional questions, for which I made an original summary table that we started handing out at meetings in August 2003 requesting some clarifications. By that time Stacey left the project and Don even missed a couple meetings for some reason. Susan Byrd has never come to any Parris Island meeting I've been to. As a result, there was never anyone to discuss these with. To date, through the merry-go-round of SCDHEC RPMs and Don's schedule, we've still never heard back from anyone at SCDHEC about these. So I went back and tried to make a more detailed summary table of where we're at that may make it easier for SCDHEC to help us kill this report. Please review this before I ship it off to the team. Tim - I have a couple spots where I need some info. Please let me know if you can help.

- 1) DHEC general comment #2, , page 3, SWMU 27 discussion, DHEC wants a map showing paved/unpaved areas. Is it possible for you to rough something out?
- 2) DHEC hydro comments #6, page 19, what is the purpose of the pumphouse (bldg 160A).
- 3) DHEC hydro comments #9, page 20, Don wants to know what (signs, orders, fences) is keeping people out of the SWMU 7 area.
- 4) DHEC hydro comments #12, page 21, please describe the well location so we can mark it on a map.

Subject: MCRD PI Action item: SI/CS RTC

Good morning everyone. This email fulfills an Action Item for me from our February MCRD PI Partnering Team meeting. The action item was to redistribute the RTC for the SI/CS document (Site/SWMU 4, Site/SWMU 5, Site/SWMU 7, Site 9/SWMU 8, Site 13C/SWMU 13, Site/SWMU 16, SWMU 27, and SWMU 35). As a reminder, I errantly distributed a green-cover (final) document in July 2002 prior to having the team concur with RTC, and without making all the revisions required by the RTC. To keep the long story shorter and keep things simpler, please ignore that July 2003 SI/CS document. Following the team concurring with these attached RTC, we will reissue a genuinely updated green-cover (final) SI/CS document. Please note the EPA had earlier agreed with the majority of the RTC we proposed to EPA comments, and EPA issued a follow up letter in October 2002 detailing a few outstanding issues. The RTC for those few remaining issues is attached.

The attached RTC have previously been distributed to the team on multiple occasions, and with one exception, are identical at each occurrence. The exception is on EPA's final comment addressing SWMU 35 where I updated the RTC to reflect that summaries of EPA sampling and Navy/MCRD work, occurring since the date of the comment, will be included in the Report.

Somewhat related to the above: Additional site investigation at Site/SWMU 7 and Site 13C/SWMU 13 was undertaken in September, 2004. Summaries of these field events can either be provided as an addendum to the SI/CS report or incorporated into the appropriate sections of the SI/CS report once the team has an opportunity to review this information via an interim deliverable (not yet distributed).
